ERC Spring 2020 Bible Reading Plan

Paul was poured out like a drink offering to finish his mission (2 Tim 4:6), but only by the power of the Holy Spirit who was poured out at Pentecost. In the book of Acts, Luke records the expansive work of the Spirit through the early church taking the Gospel to Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and to the end of the earth.

This semester we'll look at the big picture map of how and where the Gospel spread following Christ's ascension. We'll start by looking back at Joel who prophesied Pentecost, warned about the Day of the Lord, and assured God's people that through faith and repentance he will save and bless them.

As we read through Acts, we'll pause to zoom in on a few letters that Paul wrote to teach and encourage the churches as they sought to obey God in their authority structures, understanding of sound doctrine, and changing cultural priorities as the Gentiles poured in.

Paul fought the good fight, finished the race, kept the faith. The same Spirit that was at work in him is at work in all who love the appearing of the righteous judge. Do not grow weary! We look forward to a crown of righteousness on that Day. (1 Tim 4:7-8)
